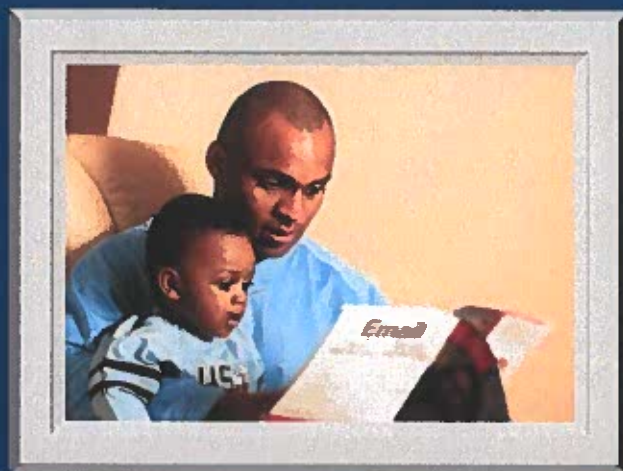
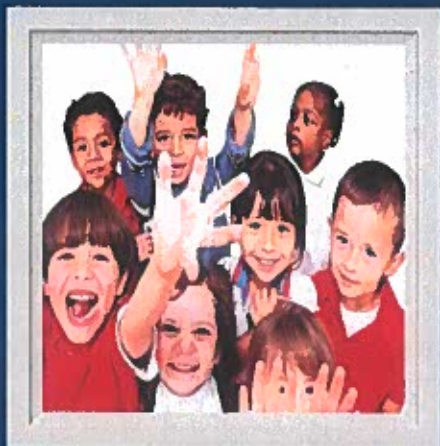

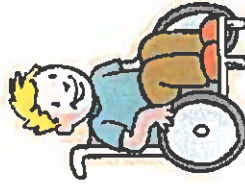

- Proof of all income (your most recent income tax return), or Texas Workforce 4-quarter Earnings Report, Child Support, SSI, subsequent payroll stubs for the previous 3 months (must verify 12 months of income).
- Proof of Insurance-Card (Private Insurance, CHIPS, Medicaid)
- Proof of Residency (Utility bill with parent's name and current address)

REQUIRED PARENT TRAININGS

Education-Parent training in activities used in the home to reinforce approaches to learning and socio-emotional development of their children in the center. Head Start offers families current information on continuing education providers with emphasis on literacy which may lead to employment and further community engagement. Financial literacy training is also provided.

- Parent Training-Observing growth and development of their children in their home environment and in the classroom setting. Parents are encouraged volunteer on campus as much as possible, participate in Parents as Partners home interaction, Parent Committee meetings and Policy Council.
- Health Education-Parents are provided the opportunity to learn the principles of preventive health, emergency first-aid measures and safety practices. Parents are offered assistance with accessing community health care providers. Parents are encouraged to establish a health care home.
- Mental Health-Provides parents with an understanding of the child growth, development and appreciation of individual differences and the need for a supportive environment. Our Mental Wellness Program provides all participants with guidance on activities and information, group interaction on maintaining healthy lifestyles.
- Nutrition-Helps parents and families understand the relationship of nutrition to health factors. With the assistance of a licensed Dietician, parents learn and children have menu choices to help develop healthy eating habits well after leaving the Head Start Program. Parents are made aware of area food banks and various assistance programs.
- Social Services-Provides parents with orientation and training on identifying and responding to Child Abuse/Neglect and Family Violence. Our program provides contact with families and agencies whose primary objective is to provide protection for abused or neglected children and families in transition.
- Family & Community Engagement provides a planned program of experiences and which support the parental role as the principal influence in their child's education and development. Our Parent Power Program provides curriculum, activities and group interaction to enhance parenting skills, confidence and self-sustaining relationships.
- Head Start collaborates with Community Partners such as Superior Health Plans, Texas Health Steps-Medicaid Providers, and DFPS by providing resources to present training on the establishment of medical and dental homes. Our staff will play a key role in assisting and conducting parent trainings in various areas of need.

Due to COVID 19 these trainings will be offered on an alternate format.

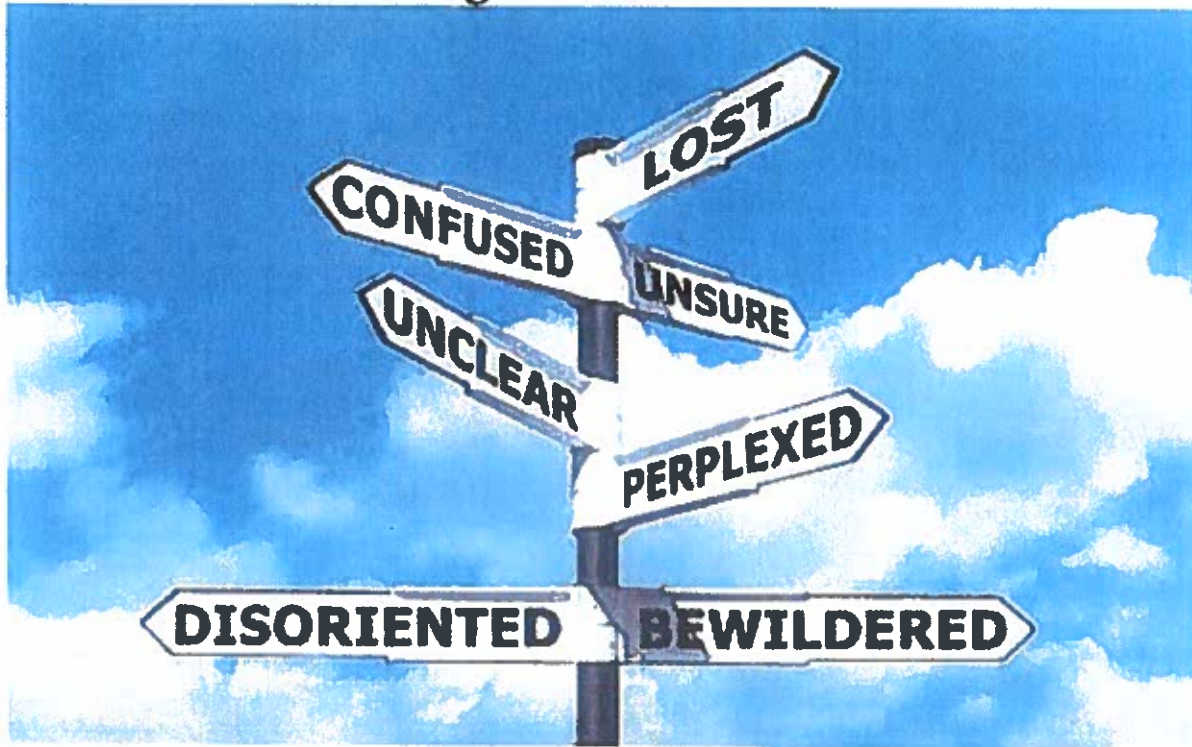
